Family Atmosphere and Academic Excellence

Divine Mercy Catholic Academy children are educated in a caring family atmosphere that is committed to excellence in education. The Ozone Park school prepares children of all ethnic and religious backgrounds with Christian moral values, knowledge, skills and appreciative attitudes that will empower them in life.

Students actively participate in monthly Mass and daily prayers. Students are aware of the needs of others and provide service through participation in drives for the victims of natural disasters and charitable programs including the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation and St. Jude Children's Research and Hospital.

The academy offers a nursery (3-year-old) and Pre-K for All (4-year-old) program as well as kindergarten through eighth grade in a safe (CCTV) and structured environment.

The nursery program uses Sadlier's Alligator Club reading program. Eligible seventh- and eighth-grade students are offered Honors math classes to prepare them for the Algebra I Regents at the end of eighth grade. Spanish is part of the cur-

riculum for grades five through eight. Students from nursery through grade eight use SMART Board technology.

The school offers early drop off from 7:15 a.m., and an afterschool program until 6 p.m. Bus transportation and the free/reduced lunch program are available for eligible students. Title I math, reading and counseling are offered for qualified students. Students score higher in state test and TerraNova tests compared to city and state results. The scores increase the longer a student is in the school.

Programs such as student council, choir, twirling, yearbook and band are available. The student council plans activities for Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas and Catholic Schools Week, which are fun for both young and old, and often of service to others. Parents have the opportunity to help the school and meet other parents at events such as car washes, carnivals, Christmas wreath sales and the annual student fashion show.

For registration or information, the school office will be open Aug. 27-30, 8 a.m. - 12 p.m., and Sept. 4, 11 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Resurrection Ascension Catholic Academy in Rego Park has been educating children for over 75 years.

The academy's motto, "Rise...Aspire...Challenge...Achieve," exemplifies the school's high expectations and belief in the abilities and talents of each student. The diverse student population represents over 50 different countries. Resurrection Ascension provides a well-rounded academic education, rooted in the gospel message of Jesus.

Access to technology is a hallmark of the academy. The sixth, seventh and eighth graders participate in a 1:1 Chromebook program that allows students to utilize this technology both in school and at home. Utilizing Google Classroom allows students to collaborate while in their own homes. Feedback from teachers is immediate.

Primary students have access to iPads, and utilize them in a group setting. A weekly computer class rounds out the students' technology education.

This year, the academy is implementing the Lab Learner STEM program for

grades kindergarten through eighth grade in a new state of the art STEM lab. Students will perform hands-on inquiries and experiments weekly, using research quality equipment.

In addition to an outstanding academic education, Resurrection Ascension students are given the opportunity to explore their talents in the arts.

Third graders are introduced to the violin through a 15 week program through Midori & Friends. Fourth and fifth graders explore the world of ballroom dancing during 20 week course from Dancing Classrooms.

Stages on the Sound provides fourth, sixth and eighth graders an experience that includes film making, playwriting and Shakespeare. Each student from pre-k through grade eight have weekly art and music classes.

The basis of all work at the academy is a love of God and dedication to service. Students learn to give of their time and talent to improve the lives of others through food drives, fundraisers and in-school service.
