Holy Child Jesus Catholic Academy (HCJCA) is located in a beautifully diverse residential area of northern Richmond Hill, near the idyllic and country-like setting of Forest Park and the "Triangle" area convergence of Myrtle, Hillside and Jamaica avenues, where the famous Triangle Hofbrau restaurant once stood for more than 100 years.

Likewise, Holy Child Jesus has provided Catholic education to the parishes of Holy Child Jesus and Our Lady of the Cenacle for over 100 years.

Located on a 86th Avenue between Myrtle and Jamaica avenues, HCJCA consists of two inter-connected buildings housing 20 classrooms, library, Innovation and STEM labs, art and faculty rooms, cafeteria and gymnasium serving UPK through grade eight.

The academy is a family in Jesus Christ where the program includes religion as a major subject. There are many opportunities for students to learn about their faith, including monthly liturgies and preparation for the sacraments.

HCJCA students are taught in a nurturing and loving atmosphere where the

Gospel message is a reality on a daily basis.

The academy provides an environment of academic excellence where the program adheres to the call for rigor and relevance according to the Common Core State Standards.

Teaching is appropriately student-centered, with an emphasis on students thinking deeply and applying knowledge in a wide range of formative and summative assessment opportunities.

HCJCA follows NY State curriculum and Diocese of Brooklyn standards. In addition to traditional subjects, HCJCA offers Spanish, art, physical education, music, technology classes and an Aquinas Program for gifted and talented students in seventh and eighth grades.

Seventh- and eighth-grade students also have an opportunity to qualify for the National Junior Honor Society. Students in eighth grade may participate in Algebra Regents leading to high school credit. This year, 100 percent of students sitting for the Regents passed the exam.

HCJCA also offers an after school band program, art club, choir, test prep, yearbook and a LEGO and Robotics Club.

Our Lady of Hope also offers National Junior Honor Society and a Siena Club (part of the Aquinas Society of the Diocese of Brooklyn) as enrichment programs for hardworking and conscientious students in seventh and/or eighth grade.

It also sponsors a Catholic Youth Organization sports program and a Youth Ministry Group.

Early Childhood Programs

Aside from a full academic and religious program for kindergarten through eighth grade, the school also has nursery and pre-kindergarten programs, as well as affordable morning care and after school programs to assist parents with child care.

The school enrolls over 600 students and benefits from a diverse national population. Class sizes range from 18 to 30 students, and 90 percent of Our Lady of Hope graduates started as pre-kindergarten or kindergarten students.
