The educational vision of the academy is to provide a solid foundation for children of multicultural communities, so that they may grow into young people exemplifying excellence in character, competence, critical thinking and creativity.

St. Frances Cabrini Catholic Academy strives to maintain an academically challenging, inclusive, safe and caring environment where students will encounter the person of Jesus Christ and embrace Him intellectually, spiritually and emotionally. Furthermore, faculty and staff seek to instill within each student the desire to embrace lifelong learning.

A newly installed LabLearner Stem Lab is utilized by all students, grades one through eight. In order to maximize small-group instruction, 4K LED IQ technology boards are also used in grades one through eight. Students can connect both iPads and lesson content seamlessly with each other and the teacher.

An after-school program is offered five days a week, through 6 p.m., to help working parents.
