## St. Vincent Ferrer HS

St. Vincent Ferrer High School is located in a safe, accessible, quiet part of the Upper East Side of Manhattan, but its students come from all over to attend this Catholic college preparatory school.

Students travel from Connecticut, New Jersey, and virtually every neighborhood in the five boroughs.

The reason is clear: the education they receive at Ferrer is worth the investment.

At Ferrer, a girl acquires the tools she needs to succeed in college. The state-of-the-art school building is comprised of five floors of classrooms and a gym, in addition to a Music Lab, three Science Labs, the Art Studio and the Language Lab.

The students study and receive college credit in Advanced Placement (AP) English, U.S. History, European History, Calculus, Chemistry, French, Spanish and Geography. They may also earn college credit from St. John's University in Biology and Spanish.

Ferrer offers its girls a challenging, successful education to meet the demanding needs of today, but is based on the 800-year-old tradition of Dominican pursuit of truth through study.

The school community is committed to its Catholic identity. In addition to the Religion classes, which all students take, there is a vibrant campus ministry, the opportunity for regular reception of the sacraments, school liturgy, morning and afternoon prayer and other opportunities to grow in the faith.

Ferrer is large enough to offer options in academics and after-school activities, but each student is known and valued. The school is committed to each girl who joins us as a student.

Ferrer offers more than 50 extracurricular and sports opportunities, including

varsity soccer, basketball, volleyball, softball, track and cheerleading, and junior varsity basketball, intramural soccer and lacrosse.

Because students live in an increasingly globalized world, Ferrer offers two student educational tours each year – open to all students – to places such as England and France, Italy, Greece, Spain, Peru, China, Ecuador and the Galapagos, Costa Rica, and Japan.

For the most ambitious students, Ferrer offers the Scholars Program and the Pre-Med Advantage Program. The girls in these programs have a wealth of success in college and beyond. The girls study organic chemistry, anatomy and physiology, and biochemistry in addition to AP Chemistry.

When the Scholars and the Pre-Med Advantage students graduate from Ferrer they enter some of the most prestigious colleges in the country, including St John's University Doctor of Pharmacy program, the Sophie Davis School of Biomedical Education for a combined B.S./M.D. program, and Duke and Cornell.

Last year, three of the Pre-Med Advantage students began their pre-med programs, one in Duke and two in Cornell.

Ferrer offers all of these advantages despite its modest tuition.

Explaining the reason she chose Ferrer, one girl said: "Everybody at Ferrer is great. The teachers really know their subject material, the girls are very nice and inclusive, and the building is in a really great neighborhood. I'm so happy that I came to Ferrer."
