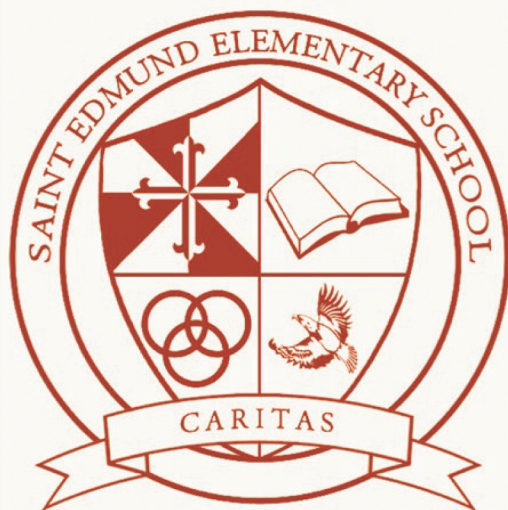
▲ The Nerd Herd at St. Edmund Elementary School, Sheepshead Bay, won the FIRST Lego League Robotics Competition on Jan. 6.
