### **Early Childhood Programs**

Aside from a full academic and religious program throughout the academy, Our Lady of Hope offers a rigorous early childhood program for children in nursery, pre-kindergarten and kindergarten with the emphasis on literacy and basic math skills, along with hands-on learning opportunities for creative expression. The staff provides learning experiences appropriate for each grade level with the goal of helping children develop to their highest potential in a manageable class size. The students have full access to tablets and Chromebooks to enhance interactive learning.

#### **Encouraged to Excel**

Our Lady of Hope focuses on inspiring a love of learning in its students. It

strives to meet the intellectual needs of all its students to create a challenging atmosphere where all are encouraged to reach their fullest potential. The school enrolls over 600 students and benefits from a diverse national population. Our Lady of Hope continually updates its academic curriculum and standards in accordance with New York State regulations to keep its students learning at a rigorous and advanced level. Each classroom is equipped with SMART Board technology, WiFi access, Chromebooks and tablets.

#### Arts, Foreign Language, Clubs

The school offers art, music and foreign language classes as well as a variety of academic and social development clubs after school. Our Lady of Hope participates in the National Junior Honor Society (middle school) and a Siena Club (part of the Aquinas Independent Study Program) as enrichment programs for hardworking and conscientious students in seventh and/or eighth grade. Our Lady of Hope also participates in the Catholic Youth Organization sports program and a Youth Ministry Group.

A new STREAM Lab, featuring the Lab Learner system, is equipped with resources that allow students to supplement classroom experiences through problem solving and project-based activities to develop deeper levels of understanding of science, technology, religion, engineering, arts education and mathematics.

Additionally, kindergarten through eighth-grade students receive sacramental preparation, and are encouraged to participate in choir, band, orchestra, Catholic Youth Organization (CYO) sports and scouting programs that apply to their age.

The school also offers full- and half-day nursery classes (age three), and a free, full-day Pre-K for All Program, which includes breakfast and lunch. Before and after-school programs are available for all students.
