The school prepares students to become accomplished 21st-century learners.

Our lady of Fatima School follows the New York State curriculum in all core subjects (math, English language arts, science, literature, social studies), and special subjects (Spanish, technology, art, physical education and music). Students participate in a performing arts program that is connected to their religion classes in Grade 1 (Christmas Pageant), Grade (Thanksgiving Pageant), Grade 5 (Stations of the Cross) and Grades 6, 7 and 8 (Living Nativity).

Faculty and staff run various extracurricular activities including yearbook, honor society, student government, choir, band and orchestra. Students in kindergarten through eighth grade use the school's dynamic technology center while also accessing computers in the classroom. The junior high school curriculum integrates all technology, including iPads, in the class-

Our Lady of Fatima School employs teachers that are already New York State certified or on the path to obtaining their state certification. Living as models of the Catholic faith, teachers participate in community service, both in Jackson Heights and in their home parishes and neighborhoods. Our Lady of Fatima School offers a well-rounded approach to child development. Students enjoy an extended daily break to incorporate active play and social development. The students benefit from the NYC breakfast and hot lunch program and an enriched afterschool program. In this rapidly developing technological world, it's essential for students to have strong technological skills. Students in St. Luke School enroll in technology classes in pre-kindergarten through grade eight in the school's state-of-the-art computer lab. Students in grades five through eight enroll in an additional Technology Across the Curriculum (TAC) class using

Chromebooks and Google Apps for Education, which ensures that St. Luke students are prepared to understand and adapt to new technologies.

St. Luke School has both a reading and math specialist on staff to assist and support those students who struggle in those areas. Special Education services are also offered, with SETTS, Speech, occupational therapy and a guidance counselor available.

St. Luke School holds membership in National Catholic Education Association. As part of the Diocese of Brooklyn and Oueens, the school is subject to and bound by the general policies of the diocese. St. Luke School also complies with the regulations and requirements of the N.Y.S. Education Department.

Students enrolled in St. Luke enjoy a structured yet flexible learning environment. Through a program of basic academic skills, students are encouraged to develop their talents and to achieve their optimum level of performance so that they will continue to reach higher levels of understanding.
