Our Lady Queen of Martyrs Catholic Academy (OLQMCA) in Forest Hills is a Catholic, co-educational school offering classes from nursery to grade eight. The academy offers full-day nursery and NYC's PreK for All, and provides a quality education for children while assisting in their creative formation. The educational program promotes spiritual and academic growth based on the Gospel message.

Along with meeting all New York State and diocesan educational requirements, the academy has the following enrichment and service programs: extended day services from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., monthly liturgies, reading and math support, field day, diocesan math bees, altar service, band, CYO basketball, student council, spring and Christmas musical revues, annual talent shows, youth group (grades seven and eight), new fully stocked STEM lab and iPads available for all classes.

Each teacher utilizes SMART Board or Promethean board technology for daily instruction. Kindergarten through eighth graders attend art, computer, library, music, physical education and Spanish class each

week. PreK for All classes follow NYC requirements. Ninety-seven percent of graduates are accepted to Catholic high schools in the area. There is also a full-time Department of Health nurse on staff.

OLQMCA is proud of its commitment to partner with families in the education of each child. This strong bond helps foster a true family-centered atmosphere. The academy is proud to boast of a strong faculty, many of whom have been at the school for more than 30 years and who provide a constant, positive presence in the children's lives. The academy has a strong parent group that plays an active role in the school community.

OLQMCA encourages students to explore their strengths and challenges through diverse instruction. The faculty utilizes knowledge of both student and community to foster an atmosphere recognizing the many cultures and customs of each individual. The academy strives to cultivate a nurturing environment where students feel free to express their talents. OLQMCA provides children with the necessary skills for long-term success.
