For students who need extra educational support, the academy has Title I services in literacy and math, ELL services, full-time SETSS teachers, speech therapy and guidance counselors.

growth mindset that suggests children's basic intellectual abilities can be developed through dedication, commitment and hard work.


Smart. Creative. Resourceful
