St. Adalbert offers a free After-School SONYC program to all students in grades six through eight while also providing a homework help and activity-based after-school program for all other students, as well as free early morning drop-off.

The academy offers band and recorder, special-area subject classes of music, art, technology, Spanish and physical education as well as SETSS, occupational therapy and speech services. Also home to a vibrant CYO basketball center, students push themselves to improve and succeed in all phases of the school – athletically, academically, spiritually and socially. Families are provided with parent volunteer opportunities and fun social events throughout the school year and many scholarships are available toward tuition and high school placement.

Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Catholic Academy has been partnering with the parents of the Bayside area to educate their children since 1951.

The mission of the academy is to establish a learning environment where students are inspired to embrace Catholic values, be lifelong learners, be active members of the Church community and obtain the necessary skills for future leadership.

The academic program provides a quality Catholic education through the implementation of Brooklyn Diocesan and New York State Standards in an environment that challenges and encourages students to work to their full potential. Many students receive scholarships to the local Catholic and specialized high schools.

The academy aspires to develop many areas of each child's God-given talent. A comprehensive music program offers instruction in all grades, nursery through grade eight.

All students learn to play the recorder beginning in grade three and all students in

grades one through eight participate in the two school concerts each year. The academy also offers the Music Together Preschool Program, spring orchestra, school band and show choir.

The Arts Program encourages individual expression through a variety of mediums, explores art history and develops skills and techniques in an annual showcase. Each student in grades four to eight has individual iPads, and students in kindergarten and third grade have access to Chromebooks and iPads.

The school's air-conditioned computer lab was upgraded in the spring of 2018 and a new air-conditioned STEM lab was created in Spring 2018.

The after-school program has been enhanced with theater, music, science and academic enrichment programs.

The academy believes a strong relationship between home and school is essential, and fosters this by supporting an active Academy Parents Association and open communication between parents and teachers, enhanced by technology.
