

Six Diocesan Priests Mark 50th Jubilees

Father Salvatore J. Amato, pastor of Resurrection-Ascension, Rego Park, plans a private celebration in the fall.

Born in Brooklyn, he attended Our Lady of Guadalupe School, Dyker Heights; Xaverian H.S., Bay Ridge; St. John's University, Jamaica; St. Vincent Seminary, Latrobe, Pa.; New York Institute of Technology, Westbury, L.I.; and Fordham University, the Bronx.

He served as an assistant at Incarnation, Queens Village, 1969-77; St. Andrew Avellino, Flushing, 1977-83; St. Helen, Howard Beach, 1983-86; St. Bernadette, Dyker Heights, 1989-96; and Resurrection-Ascension, 1996-2011.

In 2011, he was appointed as administrator at Resurrection-Ascension, and was named pastor there two years later.

Father Edward A. Cassar, who lives at Our Lady of Grace rectory, Gravesend, is a native of Malta, who was ordained as a Franciscan Capuchin priest on March 22, 1969 in St. John's Co-Cathedral, Valletta,

Malta, by Archbishop Gonzi.

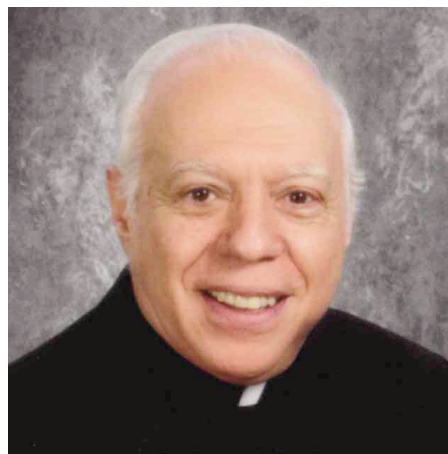
He came to the Brooklyn Diocese in 1972 and served as an assistant at St. Anthony of Padua, South Ozone Park, 1972-75 and Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Ozone Park, 1975-88.

He then spent three years in Australia before returning to the Brooklyn Diocese to serve at St. Aloysius, Ridgewood, 1991; St. Mary Mother of Jesus, Bensonhurst, 1991-96; St. Rosalia-Regina Pacis, Bensonhurst, 1996-2005; Our Lady of Guadalupe, Dyker Heights, 2005-06; St. Margaret, Middle Village, 2006-07; and Our Lady of Grace since 2007.

He was incardinated as a priest of the Brooklyn Diocese in 1979.

Msgr. Rollin J. Darbouze has been living in Florida for the past eight years where he has been ministering in the Diocese of Venice.

Born in Haiti, he attended St. Joseph Primary School, the minor seminary St. Jean Evangeliste and the Notre Dame

Major Seminary in Port-au-Prince. When "Papa Doc" Duvalier closed the seminary, he travelled to Canada and studied at St. Joseph's Seminary, New Brunswick. He was ordained there on June 28, 1969.

Soon after ordination, he came to Brooklyn where he was first assigned to St. Gregory the Great, Crown Heights, 1970-73. He then served at St. Matthew's, East New York, 1973-88.

In 1988, he was appointed as pastor of Holy Cross, Flatbush. He also was pastor at Our Lady of Refuge, Flatbush, 2000-02, and Holy Innocents, Flatbush, 2002-10.
