A Message From the Diocese's Vicar for Catholic Schools

Last year, as we opened our schools, we were in an unprecedented moment in history due to COVID-19. While we are still in uncharted waters, we are in a much better place than when we started the school year last September. Our Catholic schools have done so much in dealing with the situation, and as a result we have been very successful.

After years of closures and declining revenues, 39% of its elementary and middle schools across Brooklyn and Queens have seen a spike in enrollment over the past year. School leaders worked tirelessly in developing plans for the safe return to inperson school in order to best meet students' academic, social-emotional and faith-

based needs.

During this past year, a Year of Renewal Summit was held. The Summit was designed to celebrate our students, teachers, staff and parish communities.

The goal of the Summit was



to strengthen specific areas within Catholic education with a focus on developing vibrant and vigorous religious education in our academies, parish schools and religious education programs. The Summit addresses enrollment, academic excellence, financial viability and governance. There are actions steps being taken within the parishes academies, catholic schools and religious education programs and as a result stronger bonds have developed among the school, academies, parishes and the communities. The Summit was divided into three sections which included strong team work, collaboration and partnerships between school faculty and parishes.

School leaders worked tirelessly in developing plans for the safe return to in-person school in order to best meet students' academic, social-emotional and faith-based needs.

While our enrollments have increased, so has and raised about \$900,000 which assisted the need for scholarships and other financial aid for our students. Families have struggled to keep up with tuition payments averaging \$4,000 a year and have turned to Futures in Education to help defray the costs. Futures in Education was founded in 1989 in order to provide tuition assistance to families in Brooklyn and Queens The mission of Futures in Education is to ensure that the gift of a Catholic Education continues to be a viable option for current and future generations of deserving students. Futures in Education provides assistance to the neediest of students, through endowment funds and fund raising programs that focus on key educational priorities.

According to Executive Director John Notaro, more families sought aid during the pandemic. Last April, Futures in Education created an emergency fund to help families

about 2,000 needy families. In spite of raising this money there is still a demand for help, for each of our schools, as COVID-19 has forced schools to hire additional staff, purchase PPE equipment and other necessities to protect our students, our teachers and other employees. Although we have a long way to go, the enrollments boasts we have seen leves us hopeful for our continued success and growth.

So, as we are ready to begin the 2021-2022 school year, it is important to keep in mind the need for continued team work, collaboration and partnership throughout all that we do to so that we can preserve our schools for generations to come.
