Entry Rules:

This is a digital art contest. We are not accepting physical artwork in the Tablet office. There are no restrictions on size or art medium; artwork must be in physical form. No video, audio, or photocopy will be accepted. Contestants must fill out the form below and submit one photo of their entry.

Submissions:

Only one original photo of artwork per entry. The photo must be submitted online using the form below. Any artwork submitted online after the January deadline will not be accepted.

Entries must include:

Using the form below, make sure your entry includes your name, grade, school, or parish, contact phone number, and return mailing address. (Phone numbers and addresses will not be published)

Judging and Prizes:

Based on adherence to theme, originality of work and demonstration of artistic ability. The Tablet will notify the winners by contacting their school's principal. Winners will receive cash prizes, certificates and have their works published in The Tablet.

Eligibility:

Students in grades 1 to 12, residing in Brooklyn or Queens.

Deadline:

Wednesday, Jan. 8, 2025 at 5 p.m.

Awards Ceremony:

Wednesday, Jan. 15, 2025 from 6 p.m. – 7 p.m. at 1305 86th St., Brooklyn, NY 11228

Note: Students being recognized at the awards ceremony must bring their original artwork to the event. The Tablet staff will review the hard copy, original piece of art in person following the student's submission to the contest.
