Entry Rules:

- Entries for the art contest must be submitted digitally. We are not accepting submissions in the Tablet office. Contestants must fill out the form below and submit one photo of their artwork entry, clearly photographed, with a plain background.
- There are no restrictions on the size or medium of the art; however, no video or digitally made entries will be accepted.
- This includes no Photoshop, graphic design tools, AI-generated, or computer-generated art. Winners will be required to bring their original, hand-made entries to the awards ceremony.

Submissions:

- Only one original piece of artwork per entry. The photo of the artwork must be submitted online using the form below. Any artwork submitted after the April 10 deadline will not be accepted.

Entries must include:

- Using the form below, the entry must include your full name, your grade, your school or parish, a con-

tact phone number, and a return mailing address. The Tablet will not publish any phone numbers or addresses.

Judging and Prizes:

- Winners will be based on adherence to the theme, originality of work, and demonstration of artistic ability. The Tablet will notify the winners by contacting their school's principal or directly. Winners will receive cash prizes and certificates, and their works will be published in The Tablet.

Eligibility:

Students in grades 1 to 12, residing in Brooklyn or Queens.

Deadline: Friday, April 10, 2026, at 5 p.m.

Awards Ceremony:

Wednesday, April 22, 2026, from 6:30-8 p.m. at the Knights of Columbus Archbishop John Hughes Council #481 in Dyker Heights


